DIRECTIONS:

- For **FIRST TIME USERS:** Go to www.careerlocker.com . At the bottom of the red box, click on Register. Type in **slv-c993** in the box that says Registration Code. Type in your 1st initial & last name as your user name, enter your student number, and type in your real First Name and Last Name. Click on submit. Under Registration Part 2, complete all info. (i.e. your name, grade level, gender, ethnicity, and your "Class of 2013", etc.). Welcome to CareerLocker!
- For **RETURNING USERS:** Go to www.careerlocker.com . In the red box, enter your user name (1st initial & last name) and your password (student #). Click "login." Enter all info. (i.e. your name, grade level, gender, ethnicity, and your "Class of 2013", etc.). Welcome to CareerLocker!

Last year the goal for sophomores was to explore career interests. Now that you have had your Junior Counseling Presentation, reviewed assessments, the goal this year is for you to explore the colleges and/or post-secondary educational/training options that best match your career interests. You can accomplish this in a number of ways:

- If you're not sure of your top 2 career interests, go to the Occupations tab and click on My Interests under "Quick Look-ups," take the quick survey and find what interests you when you click "Show Matching Occupations."
- OR under "Occupational Information," you can click on Browse Occupations. You could then select the first letter or enter text. (For example, I could click on the letter "C" and then find "Counselors, Guidance" or I could type in "counselor." OR I could type in \$50, 000 & hope counseling is there or pick a career cluster and in "Education and Training," I could find School Counselor.)
- OR If you are sure about your 2 career interests, stay on the Occupations page and under "Quick Look-ups," click on Majors & Degrees." Either "Pick a major or degree area," or enter text. Once you have made two career selections, COMPLETE THE CHART.
